PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major assignments undertaken by the Directorate of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance. This Directorate has been collecting the price data related to both Wholesale and Retail. Among the Retail prices, the statement of weekly prices of 89 essential commodities is being collected on every Friday from District Headquarters. In addition to this, Wholesale prices of 52 Agricultural commodities are also being collected on weekly basis.

The Publication entitled "Monthly Price Bulletin" is a regular feature of the Directorate of Economics & Statistics. The price data reflected in these Bulletins gives a bird's eye view of the price scenario of the important consumer/agricultural commodities for the month the Bulletin relates. The purpose behind its publication is to inform the users about the price fluctuations within a given period of time.

The instant Bulletin covers the price data for the month of July, 2024 and its comparison with the data of previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year 2023 in tabular as well as in graphical form.

The data is collected by the designated price collectors working in the District Statistics & Evaluation Officers on a weekly basis. In case of Retail prices, price data from all twenty districts is collected for the listed commodities whereas in case of wholesale price, price data is collected from nine districts namely Jammu, Udhampur, Kathua, Poonch, Srinagar, Anantnag, Pulwama, Shopian and Baramulla. The weekly district-level data is compiled in this Directorate and presented in the form of a Monthly bulletin.


In addition, Labour Bureau, Shimla consolidates the Consumer Price Index for Industrial workers on Base year 2016=100 of Jammu & Kashmir centre on the basis of weekly/monthly price data obtained from six markets namely Maharaja Bazar, Pampore- Pantha Chowk, Purani Mandi (Jammu), Bari Brahmana (Samba), Samba Market and Kathua Market. For this purpose, price collectors and supervisors are appointed by this Directorate. The index is used inter-alia, for regulation of wages and dearness allowances of central and state Government Employees. The group wise Consumer Price Index for the Industrial workers for the Month of June, 2024 uploaded by the Labour Bureau, Ministry of Labour and employment) and General Index for Agricultural Labourers and Rural Labourers for the Month of July, 2024 furnished by the Labour Bureau, Ministry of Labour and Employment has also been replicated in the present bulletin.


A&B - CEREALS AND CEREALS PRODUCTS.

Comparison of UT average Retail prices of different varieties of Cereals and Cereals Products.



When compared to the same month last year, the average retail prices of Basmati (R.S.Pura), Kashmiri Chawal, and IR8 have risen by 6.00%, 22.25%, and 11.51%, respectively.


C. PULSES AND PRODUCTS.




C (ii) - PULSES WHOLE: Comparison of UT average Retail prices of Pulses Whole.

When compared to the previous month, average retail prices for pulses indicate a mixed trend.

When compared with the same month of the previous year, the average prices of Gram (white), Gram (black), Moong, Urd, Rajmash Red Large(Local), Rajmash Red Small (Local) and Arhar (Non-Local) climbed by 15.89%,11.72%,5.39%,4.88%,4.22%, 4.53% and 17.73%, respectively.




D.OILS AND FATS

Comparison of UT average Retail prices of Oils and Fats.

Except for Ghee, which increased by 5.77%, the average prices of commodities in this group were typically lower than the prices in the same month the previous year. Over the last year, the average prices of Mustard Oil (Loose, P-Mark), Vanaspati Ghee, and Rapseed Oil have decreased by 5.93%, 3.76%, 4.65%, and 5.21%, respectively.


E. MEAT, FISH, EGGS AND POULTRY


F.MILK AND MILK PRODUCTS




Comparison of UT average Retail prices of Vegetables.


H. FRUITS AND DRY FRUITS


I. OTHER FOOD ITEMS


J. NON FOOD ITEMS

When compared to the previous month's pricing and the same month the previous year, non-food product average prices exhibited a mixed trend. When compared to the same month last year, the prices of Tooth Paste, Toilet Soap, and Boot Polish climbed by 13.82%, 5.59%, and 5.44%, respectively, while the prices of Diesel and Petrol decreased by 2.12% and 2.10, respectively.


When compared to the previous month's pricing as well as the corresponding month of the previous year, the average prices of cereals and goods showed a mixed trend in price variance.


