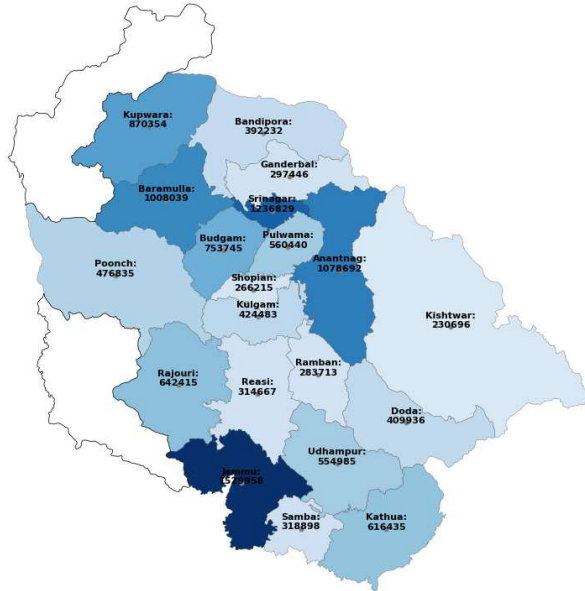


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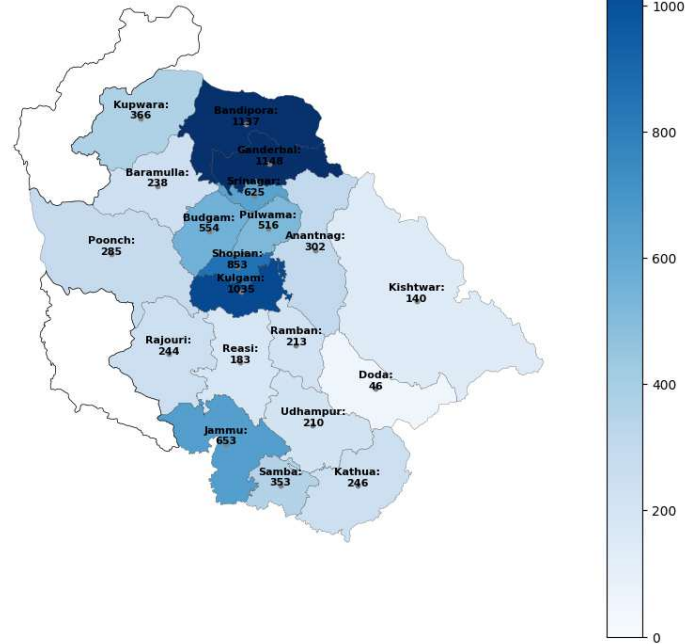


AREA AND POPULATION

(Census 2011)



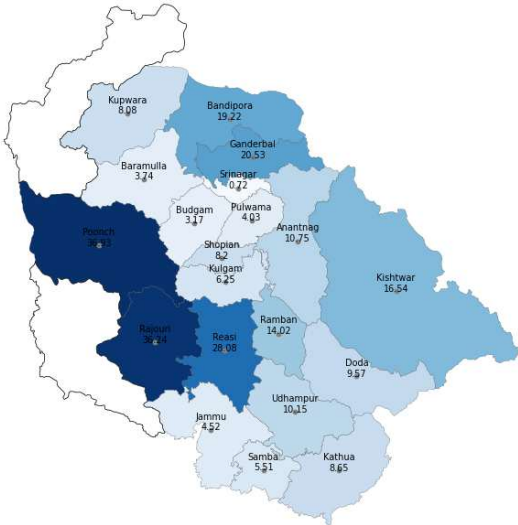
Population Density of Jammu and Kashmir
(Census 2011)



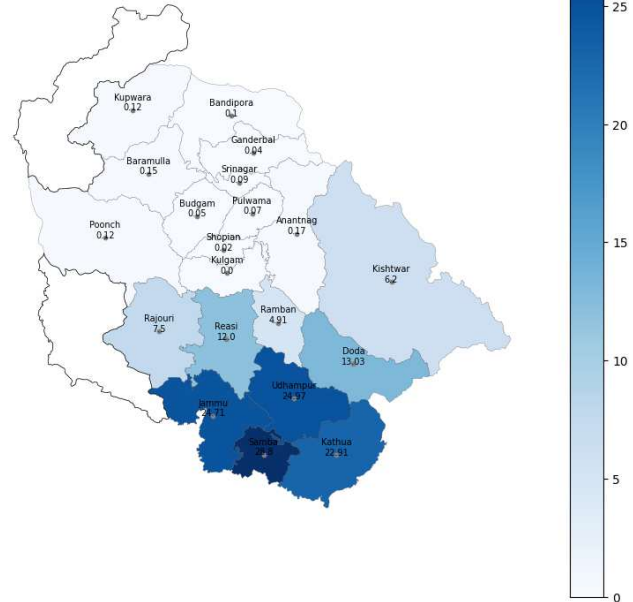

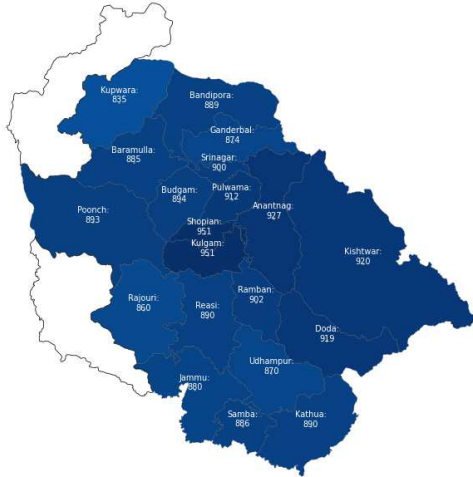

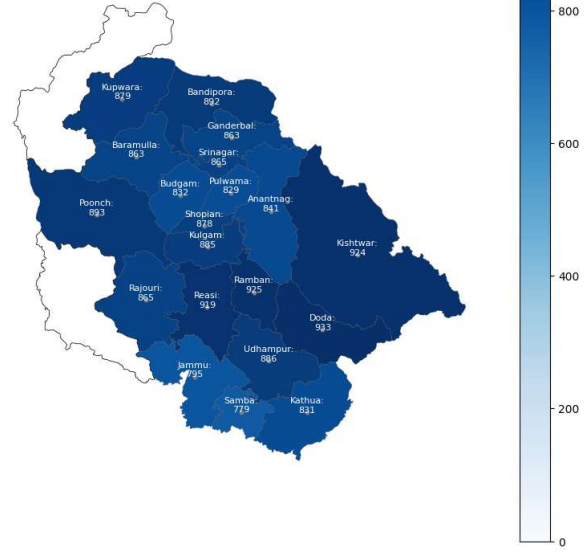

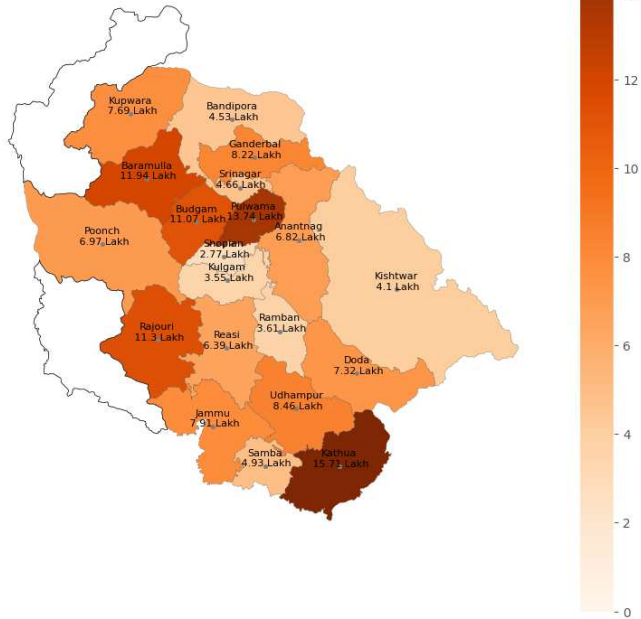

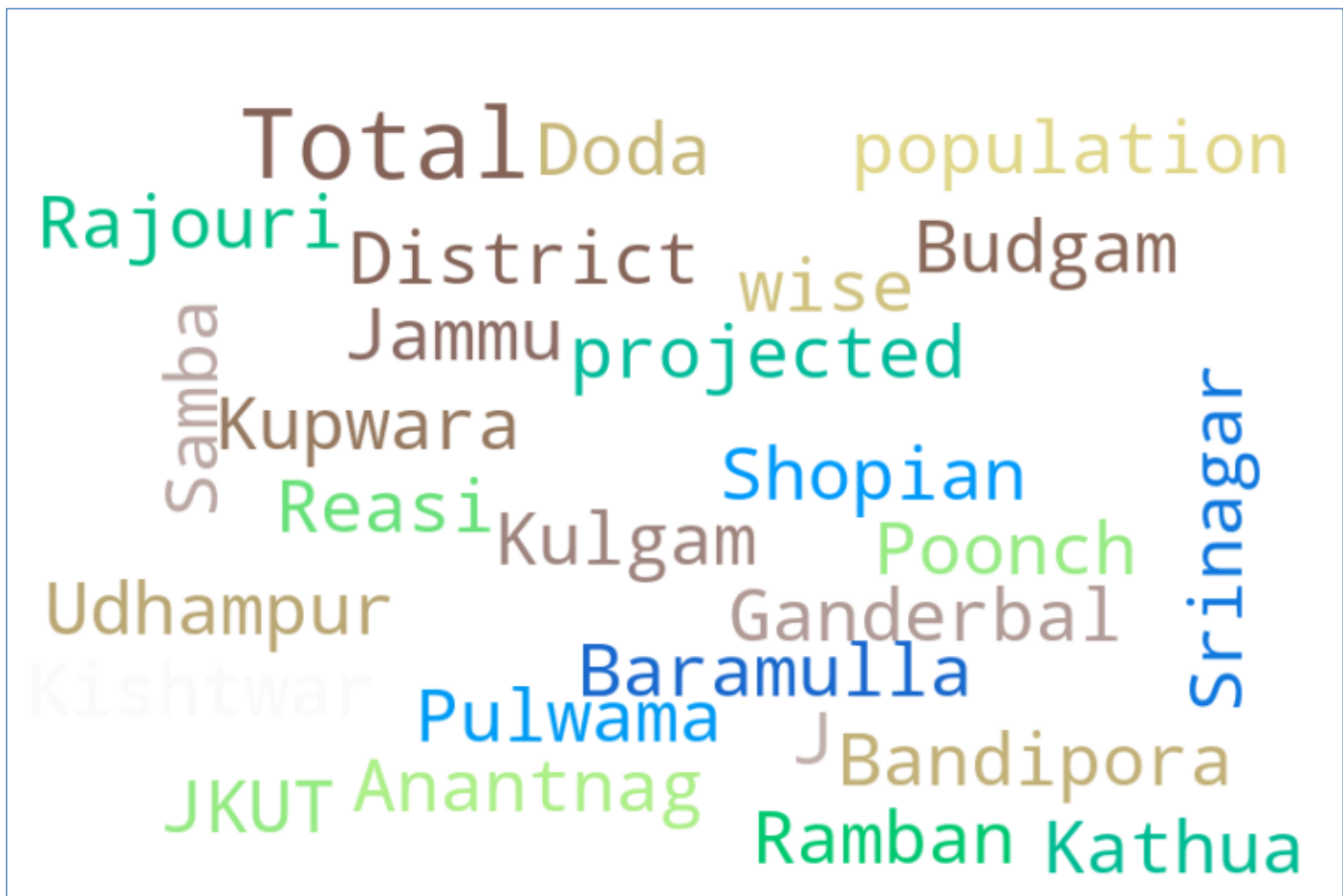
