NOTIFICATION

JAMMU & KASHMIR, THE 25th Nov, 1981.

SlO-519. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to section 124 of the Constitution of Jammu and Kashmir, the Governor hereby directs that in the Jammu and Kashmir Statistical Training Rules, 1975, the following amendments shall be made, namely:-

(a) for the entry appearing against the words, "Specialised course for Statisticians" in rule 6, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

| iii/ Preparation holidays and examination: | 15 days " |

(b) for sub-clause (iii) of clause (a) of rule 11, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"(iii) For Statisticians, the minimum pass marks shall be 35 percent in each paper and 40 percent in the aggregate. Candidates who obtain 50 percent or more marks in any paper but fail in the aggregate examination as a whole, shall be exempted from appearing in that paper. No exemption shall, however, be granted in practical paper."
